Dear Ms. Salas:

Pursuant to Paragraph 76 of the Commission's Memorandum Opinion and Order on Reconsideration, MM Docket No. 92-264, FCC 98-138 (released June 26, 1998), Tele-Communications, Inc. ("TCI") hereby notifies the Commission that (a) on September 1, 1999, TCI, through an affiliate, purchased the cable television systems in White Sands and Mesilla Valley, New Mexico, and (b) on October 1, 1999, TCI, through affiliates, anticipates it will enter into various transactions with affiliates of Charter Communications, Inc. and InterMedia Management, Inc. whereby TCI will sell and acquire cable television systems in South Carolina, Indiana, Kentucky, Utah, Montana and Tennessee.

Based on available data, and assuming the most conservative interpretation of the Commission's attribution rules, TCI estimates that prior to the transactions it had approximately 35,198,000 cable homes passed and after the transactions it has approximately 34,820,000 cable homes passed.
