Dear Ms. Salas:

On September 29, 1999, C. Michael Armstrong, Chairman and CEO of AT&T, James Cicconi, General Counsel and Executive Vice President of AT&T, Mike Hammer, representing AT&T, and the undersigned, met with Commissioner Powell, Marsha MacBride, Legal Advisor to the Commissioner, and John Cody, Jennifer Kosdyu, and Keith Murphy, Interns with the Commissioner's office. We emphasized the importance of facilities-based local phone competition for residential customers. We also discussed the need to conform the cable horizontal ownership and attribution rules to the programming concerns underlying the cable horizontal ownership statute. Finally, we reviewed the rationale underlying the cable horizontal ownership limit and the need to raise that limit.
