On October 6, 1999, representatives from GTE met with Lawrence Strickling of the Federal Communications Commission's Common Carrier Bureau in Clearwater, FL. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the comments filed by GTE on August 23, 1999 in the above-captioned proceeding and to demonstrate a cable open access system. In particular, the Declaration of Albert Parisian, in appendix D of our comments, served as the focal point of the discussion.
