This is to advise you that Beehive Telephone Company, Inc. on August 17, 1999, filed a 402(a) Petition for Review of: Implementation of the Local Competition Provisions of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, CC Docket No. 96-98, 11 FCC Rcd 19392 (1996), recon. denied, FCC 99-170 (released July 19, 1999).

Beehive challenges the FCC's determination, as applied to toll free telephone service, that it has complied with the requirement of Section 251(2)(1) to create or designate an impartial entity to administer telecommunications numbering.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 99-1328. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Laurel R. Bergold.
