Pursuant to Section 1.1206 of the Commission's Rules, this is to notify you that representatives of the United Telecom Council (UTC) met yesterday with Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth and his staff to discuss various issues related to the above-referenced dockets. Specifically, UTC discussed the need for greater frequency coordination protections for private land mobile systems licensed to utilities and pipelines; the need for a separate "Public Service Radio Service;" and the need to lift the freeze on the filing of applications for 900 MHz multiple address systems.

Attending the meeting on behalf of UTC were Stephen Carrico, of Wisconsin Public Service Corporation; Carol Gittinger, of Austin Energy; Charles Holcomb, of Williams Gas Pipeline; Robert Leonard, of New York Power Authority; and Jeffrey Sheldon, of UTC.
