**Re: Ex Parte Notification - WT Docket No. 99-168**

Dear Ms. Salas:

This letter is being filed on behalf Motorola, Inc. (Motorola). On October 5, 1999, Christopher Galvin, the CEO of Motorola; Rich Barth, Vice President and Director, Telecommunications Strategy; Mike Kennedy, Corporate Vice President and Director, Telecommunications Policy, of Motorola and Ty Brown of Wiley, Rein and Fielding met with FCC Chairman William Kennard and Thomas Sugrue, Chief, Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. During this meeting the discussion turned to the band plan (see Figure 1) that Motorola has proposed in other ex-parte contacts in the above referenced proceeding

Motorola reiterated its view that this band plan would accomplish many worthwhile objectives. Primarily it would offer protection to the previously allocated public safety bands. It also addresses the well-documented need for additional spectrum for the Private Mobile Radio Service while making spectrum available for the new generation of commercial wireless services.

The parties also discussed the Chairman's Agenda for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century and referred the Chairman to Motorola's comments at the recent forum on that subject.

Motorola indicated its willingness to work with Commission staff to develop an appropriate regulatory structure for the band manager concept that would enable the allocation of this spectrum to private wireless uses consistent with the legislative requirement that licenses be distributed using competitive bidding processes.



- 6 MHz allocated for private auctioned (PMRS), in two blocks of 1.5 + 1.5 MHz with band managers
- 30 MHz for Commercial Carriers (CMRS); 15+15 MHz.
- 24 MHz for public safety (allocation completed)
