This Agreement is made by and between Bell Atlantic Network Services, Inc., a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Delaware, with offices at 1320 North Court House Road, Arlington, Virginia 22201, on behalf of Bell Atlantic - Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Bell Atlantic") and Bell Atlantic Global Networks, Inc., ("GNI") a corporation formed under the laws of the State of Delaware, with offices at 1320 North Court House Road, Arlington, Virginia 22201.

WHEREAS, GNI desires that Bell Atlantic provide special construction services as described below; and

WHEREAS, Bell Atlantic is willing to do so in accordance with applicable filed and effective tariffs and the terms of this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises which follow and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties, intending to be legally bound hereby, agree as follows.

1. SCOPE OF AGREEMENT AND SERVICES

Bell Atlantic will provide the following special construction services ("Services") to GNI: a diversely routed fiber riser cable at the GNI POP location at 401 N Broad Street, 3rd floor, Philadelphia, PA. Service installation will be completed within approximately 5 weeks from receipt of a signed contract. Service will be installed subject to the following terms and conditions:

- GNI will provide adequate and secure space and power for Bell Atlantic equipment.
- GNI is responsible for providing the transport structure/pathway in the building from the entrance to the location of the Bell Atlantic equipment and the transport structure/pathway on private property.
- GNI will be responsible for securing any permits and right-of-ways on private property, as well as new building entrance, if required.
- If this request is subsequently cancelled by GNI, GNI will be responsible for cancellation charges, as applicable.

The Services will be provided in accordance with this Agreement and Bell Atlantic's applicable and effective tariffs, as amended from time-to-time ("Tariffs"). The Tariffs are hereby made a part of this Agreement and are incorporated by reference.

2. PRICE

GNI shall pay Bell Atlantic a one-time charge of \$5,431.00 for the Services. Additional charges may apply if this request is altered or if out of hours installation is requested by GNI. Any additional charges will be subject to an amendment to this contract.

3. COMPLIANCE WITH LAW, GOVERNING LAW, AND SEVERANCE

a. The parties shall comply with all applicable laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, and orders or decisions of governmental bodies of competent jurisdiction in performing this Agreement.

b. This Agreement shall be construed in accordance with, and governed by, the laws of the Commonwealth of Virginia.

c. In the event that any provision of this Agreement is held to be in violation of applicable laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, orders, and decisions or is held to be unenforceable, such holding shall not


