I am writing this letter in an effort to emphasize how important private spectrum at 746-806 MHz is for two-way radio sales organizations. I own five organizations within the Atlanta, GA and Charleston, SC areas. We are Motorola sales, service, and warranty center. We serve a wide variety of customers from small to large. We serve public safety entities, contractors, real estate agents, apartment complexes, and numerous other types of organizations. We sell and service customers who need communications on-site and wide area.

Congestion for current land mobile radio users is worsening. Especially within the Atlanta and metro Atlanta markets, suitable frequencies are rare. We have more and more customers who are re-licensing on a more regular basis just in an effort to find cleaner channels. They do not understand why the spectrum is such a difficult part of their radio systems.

The private sector needs more spectrum. This problem has been growing for several years. The 746-806 spectrum is a good location. And, a band manager idea could be a solution in providing spectrum for the private users and the need of the auction requirements.
