





LICENSEES REQUIREMENT AND RESPONSIBILITY TO CURE RADIO INTERFERENCE

The proposed transmitter site location is presently used by a very limited number of two-way radio users. We therefore expect no interference whatsoever, due to the limited amount of receivers and other transmitters in the area. The applicant has employed the Company that maintains almost all of the two-way radios "On site" as well as the area. This company has installed all of the two-way radios at this site. His company has done a complete "channel study" of all licensed or operating systems in a one mile radius of the proposed FM broadcast tower/station. This study finds that the proposed station has no "IF" related channels within the study area.

The applicant is aware of the possibilities of some interference occurring, in or near the proposed broadcast station. Should any such interference occur because of the operations of the proposed FM broadcast station, the applicant, Fatima Response, Inc., through this exhibit states that it will except full responsibility for the prompt elimination of and all objectionable interference that may be caused to any existing or new users within the proposed stations 115 dBu contour area. The applicant will employ Mr. Hansen to check on any occurrences of radio interference and to solve the problem if and when it arises.

The instant application meets and exceeds the ANSI "Worst Case" exposure levels and is categorically removed from consideration. The applicant will reduce power or cease operations while workers are on or near the tower. The applicant will provide a non-required fence around the entire transmitter site/tower. The site will be posted notifying all persons of the RF energy being transmitted from the site.

## **EXHIBIT 'A'**

- J. Health programs;
- K. Job training, appropriation and commentary

Educational programs to achieve the foregoing will include Biblical analysis and interpretation, commentary, religious current affairs and news, secular current affairs and news, devotional services and sacred, classical and popular music, together with community service and activities announcements of the service area.

## EXHIBIT 'B'

**PURPOSE:** To establish an FM Non-Commercial educational broadcast station to provide a wide and variant scope of educational, cultural, and ecumenical religious programming for the proposed area.

**OBJECTIVES:** To serve the entire community within the proposed area. To provide opportunities for the airing of cultural enhancement programs among the many nationalities in the area, thereby providing for educational as well as religious and social growth for minorities, as well as the majority of the citizens of the area. As a non-commercial applicant, Fatima Response, Inc., will strictly comply and adhere to all the requirements imposed by the Commission concerning the acceptance of commercial announcements and the sale of goods and services and will follow the dictates of the Fairness Doctrine.

During the 1980's, Sandra Soho was a 49% owner in Soho Broadcasting which owned KDAN(AM) in South St. Paul, MN, KDAN(AM) and CP for KDAN(FM) in Williams, AZ, CP for KPUB(AM) and KPUB(FM) in Winters, TX, and CP for KGUS(AM) in Florence, AZ. The licenses were sold and the construction permits expired because of the financial crisis caused when the 51% owner of Soho Broadcasting died.
