Dear Ms. Salas:

At the request of the Common Carrier Bureau staff, SBC Telecommunications, Inc. clarifies the language describing the relief requested in Ameritech's Petition for Forbearance from Dominant Carrier Regulation of the Provision of High Capacity Services in the Chicago LATA. In that petition, Ameritech requested forbearance from dominant carrier regulation of its provision of "high capacity special access, dedicated transport for switched access, and interstate intraLATA private line (point-to-point) services." Ameritech has no tariff provision separately covering the latter category of services. Rather, end users who wish dedicated point-to-point interstate intraLATA services simply purchase dedicated interstate services (special access or transport) out of Ameritech's interstate access tariff (Tariff FCC No. 2).
