
By the Assistant General Counsel, Administrative Law Division:

1. This order grants a Motion for Extension of Time, filed October 13, 1999, by James A. Kay, Jr. (Kay). The Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (Bureau) filed comments on October 15, 1999.

2. Kay seeks a 10-day extension of time until November 2, 1999 to file a reply to the Bureau's exceptions to the initial decision in this proceeding, James A. Kay, Jr., FCC 99D-04 (Sept. 10, 1999). Kay recites that his attorney is currently out of the country on a trip planned before the pleading cycle was established and will need additional time to prepare the reply upon his return. The Bureau does not object to the requested extension.
