This is to advise you that, on September 23, 1999, MCI WORLDCOM, Inc. filed a new Petition for Review pursuant to 47 U.S.C. § 402(a) of: Access Charge Reform, et al., CC Docket Nos. 96-262, 94-1, 98-157 and CCB/CPD File No. 98-63, FCC 99-206 (released August 27, 1999).

MCI challenges the FCC's Access Charge Reform Fifth Report and Order, which, among other things, gives certain local exchange carriers additional pricing flexibility in light of developing competition.

The Court has docketed this case as No. 99-1395. The attorney assigned to handle the litigation of this case is Laurence N. Bourne.
