
RE: CC Docket No. 94-102, Ex Parte Notice of October 28th Meeting with Wireless Bureau Staff

Dear Ms. Salas:

On October 28, 1999, the following parties met with Wireless Bureau staff, including Nancy Boocker and James Schlichting regarding wireless E9-1-1 deployment issues: Laverne Hogan and John Melcher on behalf of the Greater Harris County 9-1-1 Emergency Network and Richard A. Muscat on behalf of the Texas Commission on State Emergency Communications and the National Association of State Nine-One-One Administrators. The parties discussed the recent Third Report and Order in CC Docket No. 94-102 consistent with their previously filed comments. The parties also discussed current wireless E9-1-1 Phase I implementation activities in Texas, the cost recovery requirement in the current FCC rules, and filings related to the Non-Call Associated Signaling vs. Call Associated Signaling debate. It was also discussed that the Commission might consider an Agenda item on the latter two issues soon.
