REPLY COMMENTS AND WITHDRAWAL OF OBJECTION

Capstar Royalty II Corporation ("Capstar"), licensee of station KTTI(FM), Yuma, Arizona, by its attorneys, submits these reply comments in order to withdraw its previous objection to the counterproposal, advanced in "Comments and Alternate Proposals" filed on August 23, 1999 by Desert West Air Ranchers Corporation ("Desert West"), to reallocate Channel 236C from Winslow, Arizona to Sun City West, Arizona.¹

Desert West's proposed reallocation of Channel 236C to Sun City West, Arizona is short-spaced to the reference point for Channel 236C at Yuma, Arizona, an allotment reserved for a modification of station KTTI(FM) to Class C facilities. Desert West requests the Commission to modify the reference points of that allotment to accommodate Desert West's proposed community change. In reply comments filed on September 7, 1999, Capstar stated its interest in applying for and constructing


KTTI(FM)'s upgrade to Class C facilities, and urged the Commission not to adopt Desert West's proposed change in the Yuma Channel 236C reference coordinates.

After further study, however, Capstar has determined that upgrading KTTI(FM) to Class C facilities is not practicable, and, therefore, Capstar will not pursue such an upgrade. Accordingly, Capstar withdraws its previous objection to Desert West's proposal to change the reference coordinates of Channel 236C at Yuma, Arizona. Capstar has neither received nor been promised any consideration for so withdrawing its objection.
