On Tuesday, November 23, 1999, the Personal Communications Industry Association ("PCIA"), represented by Rob Hoggarth along with Tom Dombrowsky of Wiley Rein & Fielding, met with Diane Connelly, Alice Elder, Roger Noel, Cindi Schieber and Brett Tarnutzer of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

The meeting participants discussed the status of the proceeding. PCIA shared its concerns that the long pendency of the docket had created a stale record that was in need of refreshing. PCIA emphasized the importance to the industry that the present NPCS frequency allocation be preserved. The parties discussed developments in the industry and PCIA offered to provide additional record evidence to assist the Commission staff in its deliberations.
