## Commission Makes Available Spreadsheets Underlying X-Factor Staff Studies

CC Docket Nos. 94-1 and 96-262 ✓

On November 15, 1999, the Commission released a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in the Price Cap Performance Review for Local Exchange Carriers, CC Docket No. 94-1, and Access Charge Reform, CC Docket No. 96-262, proceedings, FCC 99-345, seeking comment on the represcription of the productivity offset ("X-factor") portion of the LEC price cap formula. The Notice included the results of two new staff studies, the 1999 staff total factor productivity ("TFP") study, and the staff Imputed X study. The Commission is making available to the public the spreadsheets containing the calculations underlying these two new staff studies.

The spreadsheets underlying the 1999 staff TFP study are formatted in Lotus 123, version 4.x. The spreadsheets underlying the staff Imputed X study are formatted in Excel 97.
