

Yesterday, I discussed with Kathryn C. Brown, Federal Communications Commission Chief of Staff, matters related to the referenced proceeding. In particular, we discussed the requirement that the Section 271 checklist requirements be fully implemented before approval of a Section 271 application, and that an application not be approved based on promises of future compliance. I also explained that the Commission could establish streamlined procedures to expedite review of a subsequent application. The views and arguments that I expressed are reflected in AT&T's written comments in this proceeding.
