

Consent Motion for Second Extension of Time was filed by Reading Broadcasting, Inc. ("Reading") on November 10, 1999. It is represented that counsel for Adams Communications Corporation ("Adams") and counsel for the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") have consented to an extension until November 19, 1999, for Reading to file an Opposition to the pending Motion to Enlarge Issues (Unauthorized Transfer of Control and Misrepresentation/Lack of Candor) that was filed by Adams on October 20, 1999. Good cause has been stated for the extension.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Consent Motion for Second Extension of Time filed on November 10, 1999, IS GRANTED.
