Dear Ms. Pfelfer:

You filed for a conventional SMR station at Castro Peak contemporaneously with four other applicants who also requested authorizations for conventional stations at the same location. Rule 90.625(a) provides that an applicant must make a showing of sufficient users (70 per channel) to justify the assignment of more than one channel before additional frequencies will be authorized. Thus, none of the five applicants could individually apply for the five frequency pairs which have been collectively requested.

In order to determine if these applications were filed independently and if they could be granted in accordance with the rules, we requested you to provide information concerning how you intended to implement the station. Your May 6, 1987, response states that you have no connection with any other applicant. You also state that you have not obtained your equipment or determined whether lease or purchase it. James A. Kay, Jr., a provider of communications services, has indicated that he has no financial interest in any proposed radio system at Castro Peak.

Rule 90.625(b) requires that the station be placed in operation within eight months of the date your license was granted on October 9, 1986, your station has not been constructed by June 9, 1987. Accordingly, you are requested, pursuant to Section 308(b) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, to furnish the following information within 21 days of the date of this letter:

- (1) Has your station been constructed and placed in operation? If so, provide the date that this was accomplished.

(2) Provide the name and address of the equipment vendor, the purchase price, and a copy of the sales agreement for the equipment for the station.


(3) If the purchase was financed, provide a copy of the financing agreement for the equipment. If it was a cash purchase provide a copy of the canceled check.

(4) Provide the name and address of the lessor for your transmitter site and a copy of the lease.

A willful, false statement made in response to this letter is a violation of Title 18 U.S.C. §1001, which is punishable by fine and/or imprisonment. Failure to respond within the time provided may result in the initiation of license revocation proceedings.
