PETITION FOR RULE MAKING

Now comes NationWide Radio Stations ("NationWide"), before the Commission to make request that a notice of proposed rule making be instituted for the purpose of allotting a new FM radio service. NationWide provides the required allotment study for the placement of channel 264A to the community of Burke, South Dakota. This will be a first local aural service to Burke. According to the allotment study, channel 264A can be placed at Burke with only a 3.42 kilometer site restriction. No other channel changes need to be made.

Burke is located in Gregory County with a 1990 population of 800 persons according to the US Census Bureau. Burke is the County Seat of Gregory County that has a population of 5,359 persons.
