Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 52.16(a), North American Billing and Collection, Inc., (NBANC), has submitted the contribution factor and fund size estimate for funding the North American Numbering Plan Administrator for the period March 2000 through June 2001.¹ The NBANC Board of Directors, by resolution at its November 18, 1999 meeting authorized the contribution factor filed therein.

Interested parties may file comments concerning this matter on or before December 9, 1999, and reply comments on or before December 17, 1999. Comments may be filed using the Commission's Electronic Comment Filing System (ECFS) or by filing paper copies. Comments filed through the ECFS can be sent as an electronic file via the Internet to <http://www.fcc.gov/e-file/ecfs.html>. If using this method, please reference CC Docket 92-237 in the Proceeding Block. Generally, one copy of an electronic submission must be filed. In completing the transmittal screen, commenters should include their full name, Postal Service mailing address, and the applicable docket or rulemaking number. Parties may also submit an electronic copy by Internet e-mail. More than a one or two sentence description of the views and arguments presented is generally required. *See* 47 C.F.R. § 1.12606(b)(2). Other rules pertaining to oral and written presentations are set forth in Section 1.1206(b) as well.
