On December 29, 1999, Arvin Shahani of FreeSpace Communications (FreeSpace) and the undersigned spoke by telephone with Ari Fitzgerald of Chairman Kennard's office. We discussed FreeSpace's proposed guard band plan to protect adjacent public safety communications and a letter the Association of Public-Safety Communications Officers International, Inc. (APCO) filed with the Commission in this proceeding on December 27, 1999. APCO's December 27 letter states that, based on its review of FreeSpace's recent filings, APCO "is now satisfied that the FreeSpace proposal would provide effective interference protection."
