
On January 6, 2000, members of the Coalition for Affordable Local and Long Distance Service ("CALLS"), met with various FCC staff to discuss specific elements of the CALLS proposal for universal service and access reform. These elements included the productivity factor, appropriate levels of local switching revenues, and subscriber line charges.

Members of the CALLS coalition explained how the industry proposal would leave consumers better off than they would be under current FCC rules. The CALLS coalition was represented by: Frank Gumper, Bell Atlantic; Alan Ciamporcerro and Dennis Weller, GTE; Jay Bennett and Donald Cain, SBC; Kenneth Cartmell, US West; and myself, representing BellSouth.
