MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Liberty Productions, a Limited Partnership ("Liberty") by counsel herewith moves for a one day extension of time in which to submit its reply to the Response to Supplemental Brief, filed by Orion Communications, Limited ("Orion") on January 7, 2000 in the above referenced proceeding. In support whereof the following is shown:

1. Orion filed and placed service copies of its Response with the U. S. Mail on January 7, 2000. However, Liberty's undersigned counsel did not receive a copy or otherwise have notice of the filing of Orion's Response until Tuesday, January 18, 2000.

2. Given the filing date of Orion's response, the Commission's Order (99I-23), released November 23, 1999, and the provisions of Section 1.4 of the Commission's Rules, Liberty's reply is due to be filed on Friday, January 21, 2000. Given Liberty's counsel's location outside of the District of Columbia, in order to have the reply on file by January 21, 2000, it would have to be completed, copied and placed with an overnight courier by late afternoon on January 20, 2000, only two days after receipt of Orion's Reponse. Due to the requirement that Liberty also complete preparation of replies to two other Responses, Liberty requires additional time to prepare its reply to the recently received Response of Orion. Liberty anticipates that it will be able to place service copies of the reply in the mail on

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
January 21, 2000, while simultaneously forwarding the original and duplicate filing copies to the FCC by overnight courier for delivery on January 24, 2000.

3. Orion's counsel has authorized the undersigned to represent that Orion will interpose no objection to the requested extension. The undersigned has provided telephonic notice of this filing to all parties in accordance with the requirements of Section 1.46(c). Given the Commission's recent Order (00I-01), released January 14, 2000, which will have the effect of delaying any action by the Commission for at least 45 additional days, no party would be prejudiced and the proceeding would not be materially delayed as a result of the requested extension. Furthermore, the circumstances giving rise to the need for the extension are clearly beyond Liberty's control.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is requested that the time for submission of Liberty's reply to Orion's Response to Supplemental Brief be extended one day, up to and including January 24, 2000.


