
On Wednesday, February 2, 2000, Eddie Gleason, Director of Government Relations for PCIA and the undersigned, representing PCIA, met with Mark Bollinger, Diane Conley, Alice Elder and Kelly Quinn of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. We discussed the above referenced proceedings and stated that PCIA continues to support the removal of the spectrum cap for narrowband wireless services.
