

Dear Ms. Salas:

On February 8, 2000, Frank Gumper (Bell Atlantic) and I met with Jordan Goldstein, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Susan Ness, to discuss possible modifications to the CALLS proposal for universal service and access reform. Topics discussed included appropriate levels of local switching revenues, subscriber line charges and the recovery of universal service contributions provided for under the CALLS proposal. The impact of the Commission's recent order in CC Docket 96-98 on the local exchange carriers' interexchange access revenues also was discussed.
