On February 15, 2000, Kelsi Reeves and Don Shephard of Time Warner Telecom (TWTC) and I met with Jordan Golstein, legal advisor to Commissioner Susan Ness. During the meeting, we expressed our desire to become involved in the process, that is apparently ongoing, in which various members of the industry and the Commission are discussing revisions to the proposal for access reform and universal service originally submitted by the Coalition for Affordable Local and Long Distance Services (CALLS). We also reiterated the points made in TWTC's comments submitted in response to the original CALLS proposal. In addition, we discussed the points TWTC made in its comments regarding UNE use restrictions for the provision of special access and dedicated transport services as well as its comments regarding the possibility of regulating CLEC switched access services.


