
On Monday, March 6, 2000, Betsy Brady, Douglas Garrett and the undersigned, representing AT&T, met with Sunil Daluvoy, Royce Dickens, Imani Ellis-Cheek, Carl Kandutsch, Anne Levine, Bill Johnson and John Norton of the Commission's Cable Services Bureau.

During the meeting, AT&T presented updated information regarding the cable plant upgrades currently being completed by AT&T to enable AT&T to provide digital cable services, high-speed Internet access and telephony services over its cable facilities. The information presented at the meeting included confidential and proprietary deployment maps showing the status of AT&T's upgrade activities in various markets and confidential slides showing the status of AT&T's rollout of telephony services. Copies of the confidential materials presented at the meeting were submitted under seal and subject to the Protective Order entered in this proceeding. All comments at the meeting were consistent with the information contained in the confidential and proprietary materials.
