An informal status conference was conducted via telephone on March 9, 2000. The following dates were set for discovery:

- March 24, 2000** – Complete the taking of depositions of Ms. Paula Friedman, Mr. R. Clark Wadlow, and Mr. Micheal Parker.

Timely completion of this deposition schedule hinges on completing document discovery by Friday, March 17, 2000, in order to accommodate the commencement of the second phase hearing on April 3, 2000.²
