

Dear Ms. Salas:

On March 15, 2000, John Nakahata, representing the Coalition for Affordable Local and Long-Distance Service (CALLS), and I met with Kathy Brown and Dorothy Attwood from Chairman Kennard's office, to discuss recent modifications to the CALLS proposal for universal service and access reform. Topics discussed included unprecedented reductions in local switching revenues and long distance rates that would result from the Commission adopting the modified CALLS proposal. The proposed cost study that the Commission would undertake as a predicate for raising the subscriber line charge to \$6.00 on July 1, 2002, and to \$6.50 on July 1, 2003, also was discussed.

As required by Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's rules, I am filing two copies of this notice for placement in the record for each of the proceedings identified above.
