Yesterday, I met with Kathryn Brown, FCC Chief of Staff. During the meeting, we discussed the general status of the Commission's review of AT&T's proposed merger with MediaOne. In addition, I also reviewed AT&T's proposal that the Commission grant AT&T an 18-month waiver of applicability of its horizontal rules following the expiration of which AT&T would come into compliance with such rules as they apply. I also reviewed the various rights that MediaOne has as part of its interest in Time Warner Entertainment. Finally, I emphasized the need for the Commission to conclude its review of the proposed merger in a timely manner.
