

In accordance with Section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules (47 CFR § 1.1206), this letter is written to notify you that on Thursday, March 16, 2000, I had a conversation with Michael Sozan of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau. In response to an inquiry from Mr. Sozan, I informed him that it was the Broadwave affiliate's intent to initiate service in all of the 211 DMAs within two years of receipt of authorization and that Broadwave Network, LLC, which applied for 149 DMAs, would also initiate service in each of its DMAs within two years of receipt of authorization even though many of those are very small markets.
