

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the factual and legal distinctions between various interconnection arrangements used for the delivery of LEC-originated traffic to paging service providers, including various wide area calling arrangements.

The positions advocated by PCIA with respect to these arrangements were consistent with the positions of record in formal filings made by PCIA in CCB/CPD No.97-24 and CC Docket Nos. 96-98 and 95-185.
