
Dear Ms. Salas:

On Tuesday, April 4, 2000, Leonard J. Kennedy, counsel for Nextel Communications, Inc. (Nextel), met with Bryan Tramont, Legal Advisor to Harold W. Furchtgott-Roth, regarding the above-referenced proceeding.

During the meeting, the parties discussed Nextel's view that the Commission should eliminate its statutorily-superseded private spectrum licensing restrictions and license all non-public safety spectrum through competitive bidding. The parties also discussed the other issues presented in Nextel's comments and reply comments filed on August 2, 1999, and September 30, 1999, respectively, in the above referenced proceeding.
