Yesterday, Jim Cicconi, General Counsel and Executive Vice President, and I met with Deborah Lathen, Chief, Bill Johnson, To-Quyen Truong and Royce Dickens of the FCC's Cable Services Bureau. During the meeting, we reviewed the recently-announced changes to the Excite@Home ownership structure. We also reviewed AT&T's position on consumer access to unaffiliated Internet Service Providers. In addition, we discussed AT&T's proposal that the Commission grant AT&T an 18-month waiver of the applicability of its horizontal rules following the expiration of which AT&T would come into compliance with such rules as they then apply. Finally, we emphasized the need for the Commission to conclude its review of the proposed merger in a timely manner.
