NON-BROADCAST PUBLIC SERVICE EFFORTS

10/30/92 Based on the airing of the one-hour program "Americans Abandoned", which was presented by the Prisoners of War/Missing in Action and Forget-Me-Nots, Inc., it was decided to give the program a more localized approach for subsequent airings.

Dan Bendetti, WTVE Production Manager, met with Doug Didyoung, President of the Reading Chapter of Forget-Me-Nots. Mr. Didyoung came into our studio to introduce the piece, stating that Americans must not turn their backs on the MIA's. The wraparound also gave local information about where to call to learn more about the organization.

11/18/92 Dan Bendetti met with Ruth Seegrist, Director of Public Relations for T.E.C., to discuss production of a 30-second Public Service Announcement. The thrust of the spot is to lend assistance to relatives of those who are mentally ill.

Production was agreed upon. Dan worked closely with Ms. Seegrist through November, into December of '92. Following production, the representatives from T.E.C. were so pleased with the spot, that they requested dubs for airing on other Philadelphia television stations.

WTVE continues airing the :30 on its station. Ms. Seegrist was also approached about appearing on WTVE's upcoming public affairs show "News to You".

The tape not only included footage of the parade, but shots of the carnival that followed. WTVE took the footage they supplied and added Chyron, music, edits and voice over. This was all done at no-cost to the fire company. It took roughly 40 man hours to complete the project.

TEEN PROGRAMMING PLANS

Dan Bendetti continued his efforts to line up a high school or high schools to take part in public service programming. WTVE plans to air three-minute segments where high school students interview high school students about pertinent topics. WTVE will let the high school students produce the segments, and they will be taped in the station's studio.

10/26/92 Dan met with Mr. Alfrero, a teacher at Muhlenburg High School (Sharp & Frances Streets, Laureldale, Pennsylvania 19606), to discuss production of a series of three-minute segments using Muhlenburg High School students.

At a subsequent meeting on Nov. 19th, the students met and were very enthusiastic about pursuing the project. They need time to choose hosts, work out schedules and define topics. They said that they will get back sometime early in First Quarter of 1993.

CHILDREN'S PROGRAMMING

The following represents WTVE-TV 51's children's programming efforts for the period October 1-December 31, 1992:

"Adventure Pals"AFFIDAVIT "1"

This award-winning series for children uses a mix of stories, music, clowns, puppets and special guests to address real-life issues facing kids. Self-esteem, parent/child relationships and concern for others are some of the topics. Broadcast weekly, the program encourages the development of positive, pro-social character traits such as sharing, honesty, integrity and taking responsibility. Produced by Christian Children's Associates, there are no product advertisements or commercial breaks within the half-hour programs.

The following episodes of "Adventure Pals" aired on WTVE in Fourth Quarter:

"Making the Grade"

This installment explores cheating and how easy it is to fall into the trap. A young boy tries to get his grades the easy way, only to find out that it doesn't pay off.

"Locker Thief"

A young girl tries to forgive someone who always steals her books.

"Go for It"AFFIDAVIT "2"

A half-hour weekly children's show mixes sports celebrities with interviews to stress the importance of fitness. Guests include Minnesota Timberwolf forward Christian Laittner, former Baltimore Orioles pitcher Jim Palmer and basketball-great Kareem Abdul Jabbar. Tips and features include the proper way to place a tennis serve, how to get the most out of field goal kicks and exercises for building up ice skating muscles.

By combining profiles on positive role models, while instructing the young viewer by interaction, the show teaches fitness at a young age and lets children know that if they work hard at something, they will attain it.

The following episodes of "Go for It" aired on WTVE in Fourth Quarter:

"Episode #44"

Features Jim Kelley from the Buffalo Bills, ex-basketball great Wilt Chamberlain, All-Star Third Baseman Mike Schmidt and a figure skating tip from champion Simone Gigorescue.

"Episode #45"

Competitive horse training, tips on roller-blading and a feature with Johnny Bench.

"Episode #46"

An interview with Christian Laittner from the Minnesota Timberwolves, tips on weight lifting and a Eve Elishas talks about the sport of tennis.

"Episode #47"

Mike Motta talks about muscle building for basketball and a feature on former Baltimore Orioles great, Jim Palmer.

"Episode #48"

Tackling tips from former defensive linebacker John Bunting, a profile of Hall-of-Fame Catcher Yogi Berra and an interview with Aurthur Ashe.

"Episode #49"

Interviews on the movie "The Mighty Ducks", a football tip on kicking a field goal and a profile on Kareem Abdul Jabbar.

"Candid Kids Club"AFFIDAVIT "3"

This weekly half-hour program blends entertainment and education. Shows range in topics from book reviews to picking the right shoes for the right sport. The program takes its viewers to interesting places, such as the Sturges Pretzel factory and to a farm where a blacksmith shoes horses. The program also explores social issues, such as an interview with Magic Johnson.
