MEMORANDUM OPINION AND ORDER

Issued: February 15, 2000 Released: February 16, 2000

1. This is a ruling on Motion to Receive Reading Exhibits 17 and 17A that was filed by Reading Broadcasting, Inc. on February 4, 2000, with corrected version filed on February 8, 2000.¹ An Opposition was filed by Adams on February 11, 2000. Adams objects to the receipt in evidence of both exhibits.

Proposed Exhibit 17

2. Reading's proposed Exhibit 17 (marked for identification) was prepared by Reading's counsel as demonstrative evidence of Reading stock ownership. It is proffered as a two-page chart "summarizing the stock ownership of [Reading] 1991-92 as:" "I. Shareholders of Record Previously Approved By The Commission;" and "II. Shareholders of Record Not Previously Approved By The Commission." Proposed Exhibit 17 also was the subject of testimony of Micheal Parker, Reading's president. Both Reading and Adams rely on Mr. Parker's testimony for resolving admissibility.

3. The question of admissibility centers on the accuracy and reliability of Chart I as it appears on the first page of the Exhibit which contains a list of Reading shareholders designated as "previously approved" by the Commission. Persons whose qualifications to be Commission licensees have previously been approved of or "passed upon" in connection with the Commission's approval of a long form application will be deemed to be "previously approved" by the Commission. Metromedia, Inc., 98 F.C.C. 2d 300, 305 (1984). Exhibit 17 shows 17,674 shares that were issued to STV Reading, Inc. ("STV") represented as "previously approved" for Henry Aurandt. In order for that representation to be accepted, Dr. Aurandt would have to have been the owner of those 17,674 shares by virtue of his ownership of more than 50% of the stock of STV. See 47 C.F.R. §73.3555 at Note 2 (a person holding 50% or more of the stock in a corporation that holds stock in a corporate licensee is attributable owner of the stock of the corporate licensee). According to Reading's counsel, Aurandt was at one time "approved." He thereafter formed STV, a corporation in which Reading contends Aurandt always held greater than 50% of its stock. (Tr. 1187.)

4. In order to accept the accuracy of Exhibit 17, those 17,674 shares must be shown by reliable evidence to be attributable to Henry Aurandt prior to October 15, 1991. Because STV had not been included in any long form application, STV cannot be counted as a "previously approved" owner of the 17,674 shares of Reading stock without reliable proof that Dr. Aurandt owned more than 50% of STV prior to October 15, 1991. And arithmetically, without counting those 17,674 shares as Reading seeks to do in Exhibit 17, the previously approved owners of Reading stock drops below 50% to only 46.74%.

5. According to Parker's testimony, on or before October 1, 1991, Parker erroneously believed that he held numerical and legal voting control over STV. (Parker, Tr. 970, 977-78.) Those shares were nominally issued to STV by Parker who at the time believed that he controlled STV through proxies for 10% and by his belief that 90% had not yet been issued to Aurandt. (Tr. 976.) That puzzling conclusion was testified to by Parker and was confirmed by Parker to the Presiding Judge when Parker was testifying under oath. (Tr. 987.) Still, it cannot be determined from Parker's testimony at what point in time that Aurandt had received the 1000 shares of STV stock that appears as Certificate 25 in proposed Exhibit 17A. If Reading is correct in asserting that Aurandt held a 90% ownership in STV on October 15, 1991, there should be proof in a business record to corroborate Parker's testimony. There is no such corroboration contained in STV's stock record (Exh. 17A) and there has been no clarifying or explanatory testimony in any form from Dr. Aurandt. Reading has failed to show that Exhibit 17 accounts for 17,640 shares of Reading stock that should be attributable to Dr. Aurandt as of October 15, 1991, and no resolution of the question can be made without the testimony of Dr. Aurandt and/or more definitive business records.

Proposed Exhibit 17A

6. Reading's proposed Exhibit 17A (marked for identification) is a copy of the stock register of STV Reading, Inc. ("STV"). Reading filed an accompanying Declaration of Henry N. Aurandt dated January 31, 2000 reciting that he reviewed proposed Exhibit 17A and found that it "contains a true and complete copy of the stock register of STV Reading, Inc., in which all of the handwritten entries are my entries."

7. Exhibit 17A accounts for a total of six stock certificates accounting for 1000 shares of STV stock:

The bottom of the stub for Certificate No. 5 recites that Certificate No. 25 for 1000 shares of STV that were owned by Dr. Aurandt was "voided" on February 13, 1986.

8. The STV stock record also recites at the end of proposed Exhibit 17A that Stock Certificate No. 25 was issued on January 1, 1983, to Henry and Helen Aurandt as "original issue." But there is no original record of an "original issue" stock certificate that was issued to the Aurandts or that otherwise accounts for any "original issue" of 1000 shares.

9. There is no explanation provided in the Aurandt Declaration for the sequence of the issuance of the STV stock certificates. Nor does Dr. Aurandt affirm that the copies of the stock certificates and related stubs in proposed Exhibit 17A accurately reflect and accurately account for the initial and continuously enduring stock ownership of STV.

10. Since the reliability of proposed Exhibit 17A is highly questionable and the document has not been sponsored by a witness who has first-hand knowledge and who would be available for voir dire and cross-examination, proposed Exhibit 17A will not be received in evidence at this time due to an inadequate showing of its reliability. See Lee Optical, 2 F.C.C. Rcd 5480, 5485 (Review Bd. 1987) (hearsay must have the elements of

truthfulness and reliability to qualifying as evidence in a formal proceeding). The testimony of Dr. Aurandt is needed on the evolution and reliability of Exhibit 17A.²

Order

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Motion to Receive Reading Exhibits 17 and 17A that was filed on February 8, 2000, IS DENIED, with leave to renew the Motion based on a further showing before the record is closed.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that proposed Reading Exhibits 17 and 17A SHALL REMAIN in the record as marked but rejected exhibits.


