REPLY COMMENTS IN RESPONSE TO PUBLIC NOTICE

By Public Notice Report No. 2402 released April 11, 2000 the Commission provided public notice of the Counterproposal filed by Garwood Broadcasting Company of Texas ("Garwood") on January 10, 2000 in Docket 99-331.

In response to that Public Notice, Garwood herewith reiterates its full and complete commitment to the Counterproposal it has filed and as referenced by the Commission in the Public Notice and specifically reaffirms its full intention and commitment without reservation to apply for use of the channel requested at Garwood, Texas, if allocated, and upon FCC approval of its application, to diligently construct and operate the station.

In addition, it is noted that the Counterproposal indicated that Radio station KGUL(FM) in Edna was the subject of a pending Application for Assignment of License from Hill Country Radio to

Fort Bend Broadcasting Company 1/. It is further noted here that the assignment application was granted and the assignment closed as of April 7, 2000. Since the Assignee used LaGrange Broadcasting Corporation, a different wholly-owned corporation approved by Form 316 application, in place of Fort Bend Broadcasting Company, a new replacement letter of commitment for KGUL(FM) executed by the new assignee/licensee corporation of KGUL(FM) is attached hereto.

It is also noted that the application for assignment of license of KULM(FM) in Columbus, Texas has also been approved and the closing on that assignment is currently scheduled to take place on Monday, May 1. The Assignee of KULM(FM) remains as indicated in the Garwood Counterproposal and the letters of commitment from the Assignor and Assignee to the changes at KULM(FM) remain as indicated in the Counterproposal as filed, as do all other letters of commitment included in the Counterproposal as filed.

There are no other changes to report and all else remains as stated in the Garwood Counterproposal as filed which is reconfirmed here. As previously stated, the Garwood Counterproposal will result in the most efficient use of the available allocations in the Central Texas area to provide the greatest amount of service, both in terms of area and population,






