Dear Ms. Roman Salas:

On May 3, 2000, C. Michael Armstrong, AT&T's Chairman and CEO, James Cicconi, General Counsel and Executive Vice President, and I met with Commissioner Harold Furchtgott-Roth and Helgi Walker, his Senior Legal Advisor. During the meeting, we urged that the Commission accept AT&T's proposal that the Commission grant AT&T a waiver of the applicability of its horizontal rules following the expiration of which AT&T would come into compliance with such rules as they then apply. We also reviewed the various means by which AT&T could come into compliance with such rules. Finally, we discussed the public interest benefits of the proposed merger, including the more rapid and extensive deployment of facilities-based telephony competition for residential customers.
