Dear Chairman Kennard:

As you know, our voluntary commitment to give our customers a choice of Internet Service Providers ("ISPs"), and the principles we will use in commercial negotiations with ISPs to provide that choice, were described in our December 6, 1999 letter, co-signed with MindSpring. I would like to clarify two matters related to our commitment.

First, AT&T plans to permit ISPs to obtain Internet backbone capacity from our own service, or to supply their own Internet backbone capacity. AT&T is committed to negotiating appropriate technical and commercial terms for such arrangements.

Second, as a matter of principle and of customer satisfaction, AT&T is committed to facilitate maximum access by its customers to any content of their choosing. Therefore, AT&T is committed to developing and negotiating appropriate technical and commercial mechanisms for managing bandwidth usage associated with video streaming on a shared network, and for ensuring the availability of streaming video to customers who desire it.

Please do not hesitate to contact me should you wish to discuss these matters further.
