On May 17 and 18, 2000, I spoke by phone with Helgi Walker, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Furchtgott-Roth about the above-referenced proceeding. During the calls, I emphasized the need for AT&T to be given an appropriate timeframe in which to come into compliance with the Commission's horizontal ownership rules following the consummation of its proposed merger with MediaOne. I also discussed the various means by which AT&T could come into compliance with these rules. Finally, I reviewed the timeframe for exercising MediaOne's registration rights for its interest in the Time Warner Entertainment Partnership.
