To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing this letter to appeal an Administrator's Decision on one of our requests for funding from the Schools and Libraries Division in funding year 1999-2000. The application number is 0000147758 and the funding request number is 0000243932.

The basis of my appeal is that, according to the SLD's documentation, mathematical calculations are reviewed by the SLD and corrected automatically by the data entry system or applicants are given the opportunity to make corrections if contacted for another reason.

The application was completed on April 5, 1999. The mathematical error occurs on page 4, column 10. The error was the misplacement of a decimal point. With a \$90.00 monthly cost, the annual cost should have been recorded as \$1080.00. The annual cost of \$108.00 was erroneously inserted.

The error on our application, the misplacement of a decimal point, was not corrected automatically by the data entry system.

Mr. David Wallcot reviewed our application for the SLD and contacted me with a request to provide additional information on our enrollment and participation in the school hot lunch program. I did this on August 9, 1999, as evidenced by the fax copy sheet. Mr. Wallcot did not inform me that an error was made, which would have allowed me to make a correction before the funding decision was made.

The funding decision was made on August 17, 1999. The error was identified immediately when the document was reviewed, as \$540.00 was anticipated (based on our 50% discount) and \$54.00 was committed.

Visitation Academy made an appeal to the SLD on August 25, 1999. It was acknowledged by the SLD on September 1, 1999. Many calls were made to the SLD to check on the progress of our appeal. We were told to be patient and wait for a letter.

We waited for almost nine months to discover in a letter dated May 8, 2000, that our appeal was denied. The explanation was that corrections to the application could not be made once the application is approved, **unless proven the error is the fault of SLD.**

We submit that the uncorrected error is the fault of the SLD. The error could have been corrected before the application was approved by the SLD's data entry system. We could have corrected the error before the application was approved had Mr. Wallcot informed us of the problem in our August phone conversations.

We respectfully request that the funding decision reflect our actual situation, which is an estimated monthly cost of \$90.00, **annual cost of \$1080.00**, 50% discount, and a **funding commitment of \$540.00.**

EXPLANATION OF A FUNDING COMMITMENT REPORT

Attached to this letter will be a report for each approved E-rate funding request from your application. We are providing the following definitions.

- * **FUNDING REQUEST NUMBER (FRN):** A Funding Request Number is assigned by the SLD to each line completed in Items 15 and 16 of your Form 471 once an application has been processed. This number is used to report to applicants and vendors the status of individual discount requests submitted on a Form 471. Applicants and vendors learned about FRNs when they received their Receipt Acknowledgement Letter and must use these numbers when completing the Form 486 and Invoices. An FRN will never be longer than 10 digits. If a FRN is shorter than 10 digits, applicants are advised to add zeroes to the front of the numbers to reach 10 digits when filing post-commitment forms.
- * **FUNDING STATUS:** Each FRN will have one of six definitions: "Funded", "Denied", "Partially Funded", "Funds Exhausted", "Unfunded", or "As Yet Unfunded". An FRN that is "Funded" will be approved at the level that SLD determined is appropriate for that item. That will generally be the level requested by you unless the SLD determines during the application review process that some adjustment is appropriate, for example, a different discount percentage for that FRN than the Form 471 featured. A "Denied" FRN is one for which no funds will be committed, and the reason for that decision will be briefly explained in the "Funding Commitment Decision", and amplification of that explanation may be offered in the section, "Funding Commitment Decision Explanation". In accordance with FCC program rules, FRNs are "Partially Funded" or "Unfunded", if the total amount of funds in the Universal Service Fund is insufficient to fully fund or fund all approved requests. If the Form 471 was received after all the funds in the Universal Service Fund were allocated and it was processed, the status will indicate "Unfunded - Funds Exhausted". "As Yet Unfunded" is a temporary status that would be assigned to an FRN when the SLD is uncertain at the time the letter is generated whether there will be sufficient funds to make commitments for a particular service type at a particular discount level. - * **SERVICE PROVIDER NAME:** The legal name of the service provider.
- * **PROVIDER CONTRACT NUMBER:** The number of the contract between the eligible party and the service provider. This will be present only if a contract number was provided on Form 471.
- * **SERVICES ORDERED:** The type of service ordered from the service provider, as shown on Form 471.
- * **EARLIEST POSSIBLE EFFECTIVE DATE OF DISCOUNT:** The first possible date of service for which the SLD will reimburse service providers for the discounts for the service. Note: If the actual service start date provided on a Form 486 is later than this date, the actual service start date set forth in the Form 486 will be the effective date of the discount.
