Dear Mr. Kennard:

I take exception to your statement on March 29, 2000: "The only real interference to Low Power FM radio is from high priced Washington lobbyists." There can be real interference from Low Power FM stations. I wrote my Congressman with an example of interference from a low power FM translator station within his district that demonstrates actual interference that Low Power FM stations could cause. Please realize there is a difference between REAL radio frequency interference and FCC defined interference.

As for "high priced Washington lobbyists," I would suggest that you look at your own actions on the matter of Low Power FM. It looks to me like you have vigorously lobbied in favor of Low Power FM from the start. I would have expected the Chairman of the FCC to have taken a more neutral stance on an issue.
