By the Chief, Allocations Branch:

1. The Allocations Branch has before it a Petition for Partial Reconsideration filed by Jayson D. Fritz and Janice M. Fritz ("Fritz") directed to the Report and Order in the above proceeding, 15 FCC Rcd 5506 (2000). Thereafter, Fritz filed a "Motion to Withdraw Nunc Pro Tunc Petition for Partial Reconsideration.

2. In the Motion to Withdraw, Fritz states that no monetary consideration was either paid or promised in consideration of the withdrawal and that the Petition for Partial Reconsideration raised only a procedural argument that did not address the merits of any substantive action in this proceeding. As requested, we will dismiss the Petition for Partial Reconsideration and the actions in this proceeding are now final.
