Yesterday, I spoke with Kathryn Brown, FCC Chief of Staff by phone. During the conversation, I discussed the complex nature of the transactions involved in AT&T's effort to come into compliance with the Commission's horizontal ownership rules, a description which is outlined in detail in our filings in the record of this proceeding. I also indicated that AT&T could also be required to report prior to the expiration of the twelve-month period about its planned method for coming into compliance.
