This letter (two copies of which are enclosed) is to confirm that on Monday, June 5, 2000, Thomas K. Crowe, counsel for Econobill Corporation ("Econobill"), Nissan Rosenthal, Senior Analyst for Econobill, and Roderick Cordiner, Director of On Line Marketing, Inc., met with the following staff of the Common Carrier Bureau's Competitive Pricing Division at the Federal Communications Commission ("FCC"): Larry Barnes, Steve Funkhouser, Vienna Jordan, Raj Kannan, Renee Levy, Jim Lichford, Judy Nitsche, Josephine Scarlett, and R.L. Smith.

During the meeting, Mr. Crowe, Mr. Rosenthal and Mr. Cordiner discussed (1) the need to clarify the phrase "a timely manner" contained in Section 42.10(a), 47 C.F.R. § 42.10(a) (1999) so that information is made available rapidly; (2) the need to clarify and emphasize enforcement of the specific provisions of Section 42.10(a), 47 C.F.R. § 42.10(a) (1999); and (3) the need to clarify that Section 42.10(a), 47 C.F.R. § 42.10(a) (1999) encompasses both individually-negotiated contracts in their entirety as well as mass offerings.


