

SUPPLEMENTAL COMMENTS

Mag Mile Media, L.L.C. ("Mag Mile"), licensee of Station KFLG-FM, Bullhead City, Arizona, by its counsel, hereby submits its Supplemental Comments in the above-referenced docket. In support of its position, Mag Mile submits the following:

Mag Mile continues to support the modified proposal of Centennial Broadcasting, L.L.C. ("Centennial"), which proposed, *inter alia*, that Channel 274C be substituted for Channel 288C2 at Boulder City, Nevada, and Station KSTJ(FM)'s license be modified accordingly; that Channel 289C be substituted for Channel 274C at Dolan Springs, Arizona; and that Station KFLG(FM)'s license be modified accordingly; and that Channel 240A be substituted for Channel 272A at Mohave Valley, Arizona as that community's first local broadcast service. However, as noted previously,¹ in the event the Commission does not grant Centennial's modified proposal,



including KFLG-FM, Mag Mile requests, as an alternative, that its initial proposal, contained in its October 12, 1999 Counterproposal, be adopted, and that Channel 274C be allotted to Dolan Springs, Arizona. As noted, this is not a change in Mag Mile's position, but rather a reiteration of its position.

In view of the above, Mag Mile requests that the Commission move expeditiously to make the allotment changes proposed in this proceeding.


