Kennard and Dorothy Attwood to discuss issues affecting the competitive local exchange carrier industry. Our discussion tracked comments filed previously by Allegiance Telecom in the above captioned dockets, the potential impact of Project Pronto on CLECs if appropriate safeguards are not adopted to ensure continued access to unbundled loops, the impact mandatory detariffing would have on CLECs, as well as a general discussion of reciprocal compensation.
