
Dear Ms. Salas:

On June 28, 2000 on behalf of TruePosition, Inc., I spoke by telephone with Tom Sugrue, Chief of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau.

We discussed TruePosition's field trials of its location technology and the extent to which they demonstrated location accuracy under different circumstances, e.g., modulation techniques, topography, density of cell sites. We also discussed the extent of wireless industry expectations that location-based applications will be commercially significant and the desirability, for public safety reasons, of implementing location technologies.
