
Dear Ms. Salas:

Alex Mandl, David Turetsky, and Terri Natoli of Teligent, Inc. met yesterday with Commissioner Michael Powell, Commissioner Powell's Special Assistant Paul Jackson, and Commissioner Powell's Senior Legal Advisor Peter Tenhula to discuss matters relating to the above-referenced dockets. With respect to WT Docket No. 99-327, Mr. Mandl, Mr. Turetsky and Ms. Natoli emphasized the need for the Commission to move forward quickly with the 24 GHz auction.

With respect to WT Docket No. 99-217 and CC Docket No. 96-98, Mr. Mandl, Mr. Turetsky and Ms. Natoli emphasized the importance of the Commission's role in helping competitive telecommunications carriers to overcome the substantial barrier of obtaining reasonable access to tenants in multi-tenant environments. They discussed the problems of some building owners offering preferred access to carriers affiliated with those building owners, and recounted a recent experience whereby a landlord sought to cancel Teligent's building access lease because the building owner had entered into an exclusive access agreement with another carrier.

In accordance with the Commission's rules, for each of the above-mentioned proceedings, I hereby submit to the Secretary of the Commission two copies of this notice of Teligent's ex parte presentation.
